


NAT Types

INSIDE/OUTSIDE - who controls in (Host is Inside) LOCAL/GLOBAL - referencing something Private (Host) or Public (Server)



Inside Local = 10.1.1.1 Inside Global = 192.168.0.2 Outside Local = 8.8.8.8* Outside Global = 8.8.8.8

* If destination NAT is used this might be different (public server as seen from host)
